DSWA operates Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Events at different locations throughout the year. The **Household Hazardous Waste Program** is a service held every Friday year round to provide even more opportunities to dispose of HHW. **DSWA will accept sharps (needles) on the following Fridays at Cheswold:** March 2, April 6, May 4, July 6, August 3, August 31, October 5, and on November 30.

Items should be sealed in their original containers and triple bagged to prevent spillage. This is a free program and restricted to Delaware residents only.

What DSWA will NOT accept at any HHW event.

Latex Paint

It is not considered hazardous. Please solidify with kitty litter or sand and take to the landfill.

Containers With Less Than 1" Of Material

This can go with your regular trash.

Used Motor Oil

Oil that has not been mixed with other fuels is accepted at specific DSWA Drop-off Centers. Please call for a site near you.

Friable Asbestos

Dispose by appointment at the Cherry Island Landfill for a fee. Call 302-764-5385 for details.

Non-Friable Asbestos

Dispose by appointment at all DSWA landfills for a fee.

Unknown Substances

Unknown items that are greater than 1 gallon or 8 pounds.

What is DSWA's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program?

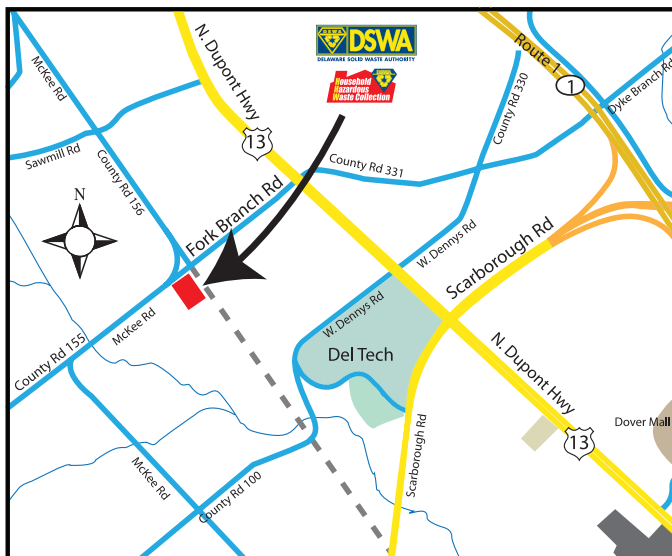
Even small amounts of household hazardous waste (HHW) can cause big problems if not disposed of properly. DSWA accepts a wide variety of items that could be kept out of landfills. What is household hazardous waste? You might be surprised. It is everything from household cleaners and garden pesticides to oil based paints and stains. Items should be sealed in their original containers and triple bagged to prevent spillage.



! We do not accept materials from conditionally exempt small quantity generators (CESQGS). For more information concerning CESQGS, call DNREC at 302-739-9403.

HELPFUL TIPS:

1. Bring materials in original, sealed containers.
2. Do not mix products in one container.
3. To prevent leakage or breakage, pack separately in absorbent material or triple bag.
4. Bring rags to clean up any spills, and dispose of rags at the collection site.
