

Collection Stations

DSWA's Collection Stations operate on a "pay-as-you-throw" basis, where the disposal fee for each bag of garbage or yard waste costs \$1.00. To protect the safety of the operator and the users of our collection stations, **NO CASH TRANSACTIONS** take place on site. Therefore, pre-paid tickets must be purchased in advance and are available in \$10.00 increments.

Residents may purchase tickets online at dswa.com or in person at our facilities. Tickets are available for purchase at DSWA's Administrative Building in Dover, our Jones Crossroads Landfill, Rt. 5 Transfer Station, Milford Transfer Station, and at the Sussex County Administration Building in Georgetown. Tickets expire one year from the date of purchase.



Cheswold Collection Station

**54 Fork Branch Road
Cheswold, DE 19936**

Hours of Operation: Monday & Saturday, 8:30 am. to 3:30 pm.

From the North: Travel Rt. 13 South, Approx. 1.5 miles South of the Cheswold light, turn right onto Fork Branch Road. The collection station is located ½ mile on the left, next to the Reichhold Chemicals Facility.

From the South: Travel Rt. 13 North, approx ¾ mile North on Denny's Road, turn left onto Fork Branch Road. The collection station is located ½ mile on the left, next to the Reichhold Chemicals Facility.

Bridgeville Collection Station

**16539 Polk Road,
Bridgeville, DE 19933**

Hours of Operation: Wednesday and Saturday, 8:30 am. to 3:30 pm.

From the North: Travel Rt. 13 South to Bridgeville, turn right onto Rt. 404 West to Polk Road.

From the South: Travel Rt. 13 North to Bridgeville, turn left onto Rt. 404 West to Polk Road.

Long Neck Collection Station

**28963 Mount Joy Road,
Millsboro, DE 19966**

Hours of Operation: Monday thru Saturday, 8:30 am. to 3:30 pm.

From the North: Travel South on Rt. 30 to the intersection with Mt. Joy Road turn left onto Mt. Joy Road. Travel approx. 5 miles. The collection station is on the left hand side just before Cannon Rd. (Look for the radio tower.)

From the South: Go North on Rt. 113 to the intersection with Rt.24 at Millsboro. Turn right onto Rt. 24 East. Travel approx 2 miles until you reach Maryland Camp Rd., turn right onto Maryland Camp Rd. Follow Maryland Camp Rd until you reach Mt. Joy Road. Turn right onto Mt. Joy Road, the collection station will be on the right. Look for a radio tower.

Frankford, DE 19945**

Hours of Operation: Monday thru Saturday, 8:30 am. to 3:30 pm. Summer (May thru September) Hours of Operation: Monday thru Saturday, 8:30 am. to 3:30 pm. and Sunday 10:00 am. to 2:00 pm.

From the North: At the Intersection of Rt. 26, County Road 54 and County Road 365 at Clarksville; go south on County Road 365 for 1 ¼ miles to County Road 373 (Burton Farm Road.) Turn right onto County Road 373 and go 1 ¾ miles. The collection station is on the left.

From the South: Go Northeast on Rt. 17 through Roxana to the intersection of County Road 365. Turn left and head north on County Road 365 for ½ mile to the intersection of County Road 373 (Burton Farm Road). Turn left on County Road 373 and go 1 ¾ miles. The collection station is on the left.

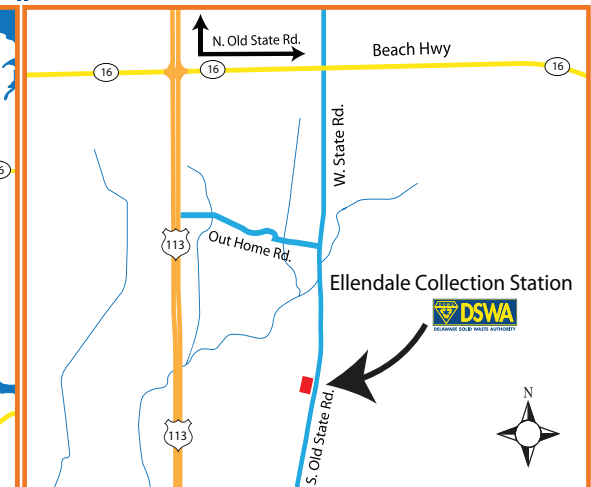
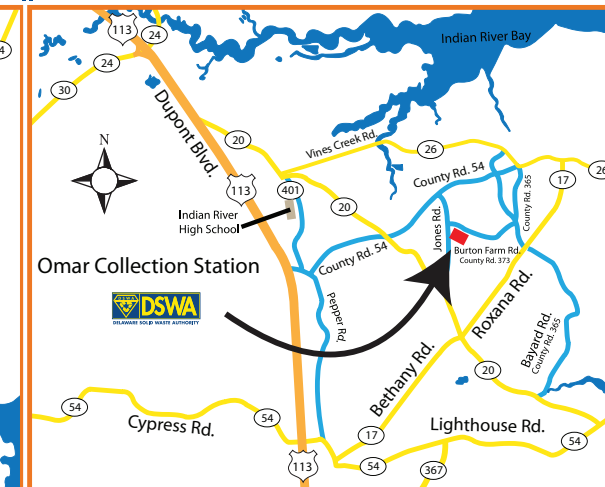
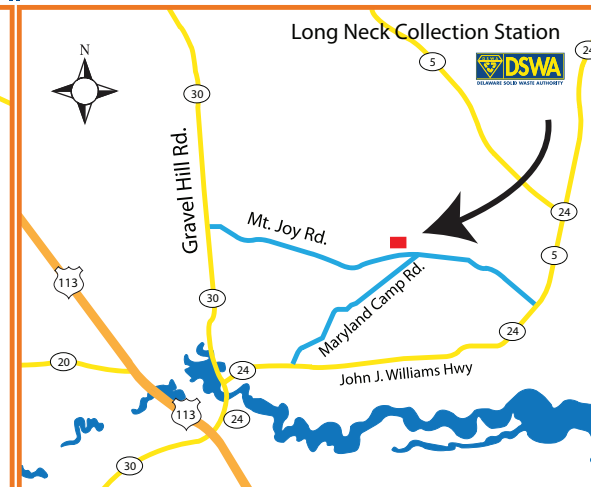
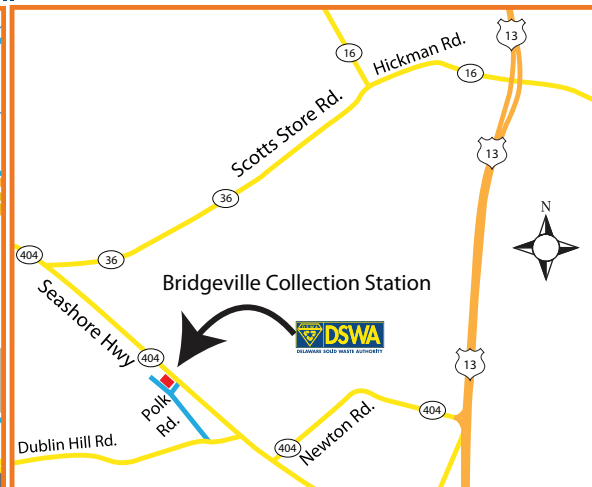
Ellendale Collection Station

Hours of Operation: Monday thru Saturday, 8:30 am. to 3:30 pm.

From the North: Travel Rt. 113 South, turn left onto Beach Highway (Rt. 16), Turn right onto N. Old State Road follow for approx 1 mile.

From the South: Travel Rt. 113 North, turn right onto Beach Highway (Rt. 16), Turn right onto N. Old State Road follow for approx 1 mile.

Yard waste brought to Collection Stations for disposal cost \$1.00 (1 ticket) per bag. Please purchase your Collection Station tickets on line or at one of DSWA's landfills or Transfer Stations. Collection Stations do NOT accept cash. See details inside this brochure.

What are Collection Stations?

Collection stations offer a convenient and relatively inexpensive option for disposing of household garbage, yard waste, single-stream recyclables, batteries, oil, oil filters and electronic goods for recycling (EGR).

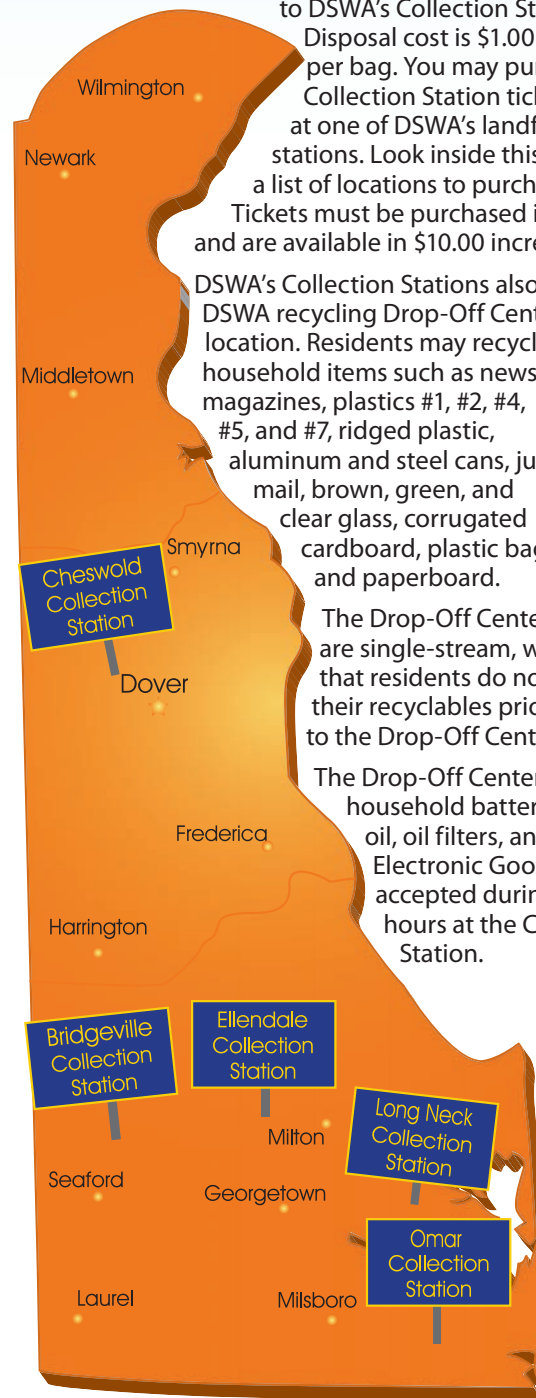
Residents may bring their bagged garbage and yard waste to DSWA's Collection Stations. Disposal cost is \$1.00 (1 ticket) per bag. You may purchase your Collection Station tickets on line or at one of DSWA's landfills or transfer stations. Look inside this brochure for a list of locations to purchase tickets. Tickets must be purchased in advance and are available in \$10.00 increments.

DSWA's Collection Stations also have a DSWA recycling Drop-Off Center at each location. Residents may recycle their household items such as newspapers, magazines, plastics #1, #2, #4, #5, and #7, ridged plastic, aluminum and steel cans, junk mail, brown, green, and clear glass, corrugated cardboard, plastic bags, and paperboard.



The Drop-Off Centers are single-stream, which means that residents do not have to sort their recyclables prior to coming to the Drop-Off Centers.

The Drop-Off Centers also accept household batteries, motor oil, oil filters, and textile. Electronic Goods are also accepted during operating hours at the Collection Station.
