DSWA BEGINS NEW CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM WITH CITY OF DOVER

The Delaware Solid Waste Authority is pleased to be partnering with the City of Dover to provide residents with a voluntary recycling program at no cost to the city residents. Current residents are able to sign up on a voluntary basis and pay \$4 per month for the weekly service. Under the new agreement the City of Dover, will cover the fee, however, the pick-up schedule will be changed to a bi-weekly service. Participants will receive a 35-gallon cart on wheels for plastic narrow neck bottle, plastic grocery bags, aluminum, steel and empty aerosol cans, newspapers, junk mail and corrugated cardboard. In addition, participants will receive a smaller bin for colored glass bottles. The bags that city residents currently use will be eliminated entirely. DSWA will provide those who sign up with a calendar that highlights pick-up days. The first collection under the new program will begin on April 3, 2007. DSWA's Sr. Manager of Statewide Recycling Rich Von Stetten said, "We are all very excited for this city. wide program to begin, we hope to see the number of City of Dover residents signed up for curbside recycling more then triple under the new plan."
