## **DSWA PARTNERS WITH REHOBOTH FOR RECYCLING PROGRAM**

The Delaware Solid Waste Authority (DSWA) is pleased to be partnering with the City of Rehoboth to bring curbside recycling to its residents at no extra fee. The City of Rehoboth will pay for those residents who wish to sign up for the voluntary recycling program. Residents who sign up for the program will receive a 65-gallon cart on wheels for plastic narrow neck bottles, plastic grocery bags, aluminum, steel and empty aerosol cans, newspapers, junk mail, and corrugated cardboard. In addition, participants will receive a smaller bin for colored glass. The bags that some current curbside recycling customers are used to using will be eliminated entirely. Participants will receive weekly Friday pick-up of recyclables by the Delaware Solid Waste Authority. City of Rehoboth Mayor Samuel Cooper said, "This is a very exciting opportunity for the City of Rehoboth, I can see this program fitting in very well with the philosophy of all our environmental conscience residents." Participants can expect to receive their materials during the later part of March and the first pick up to begin on April 6, 2007. Those residents interested in signing up for the curbside recycling program are encouraged to sign up through the City office by calling 302-227-6181. DSWA's Sr. Manager of Statewide Recycling said "DSWA looks forward to working with both the residents and the leaders of Rehoboth in making this the most successful recycling program in Delaware."
